STUDENT-CREATED 2-DIMENSIONAL ARTWORK

In support of student research in the arts, the OSU Office of the Vice President for Research and Technology Transfer is supporting a competition for student-created, 2-dimensional, ready-to-hang artwork (this includes painting/drawing/printmaking/photography). You must be an OSU student (any major) to participate. Details follow:

AWARDS: There will be two "purchase awards" of \$2000/each. Purchased art will become a part of the Gardiner Gallery Permanent Collection and will be displayed at various places on campus during OSU Research Week, February 16-20, and in the future Interdisciplinary Science Research Building. There will be four "honorable mentions" of \$500/each. Those works will be displayed during OSU Research Week, as well, but will not become a part of OSU's permanent collection. All awardees will be recognized at the Research Gala on February 17 by the Office of the Vice President for Research and Technology Transfer.

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: The ready-to-hang artwork will be displayed indoors only and can be of most any size. Although, it should reflect, either in abstract or representational form, something indicative of "the sciences."

SUBMISSION PROCESS/DEADLINE: Artwork is due for jurors' review on Friday, January 23, 2009. The work should be left in the Visual Resources Library, 106 Bartlett Center. The jurors will review your work and notify you of their decision. Winners will be responsible for delivering their work to the Research Gala and returning it to a designated location for continued display during Research Week.
